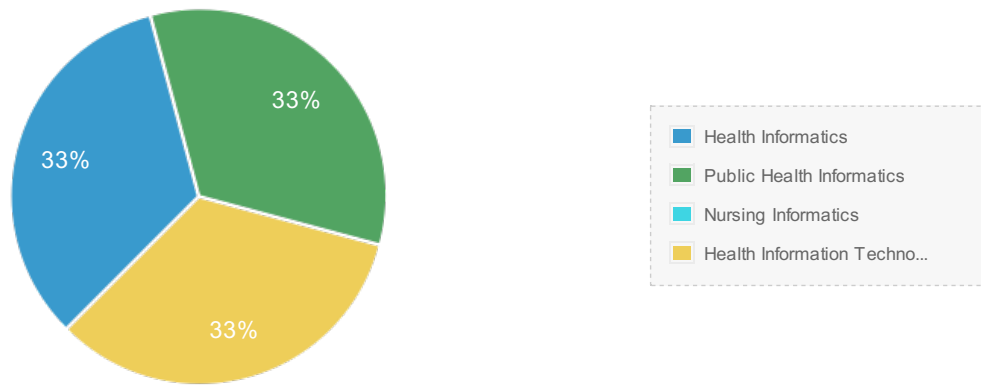

What type of class did you teach?

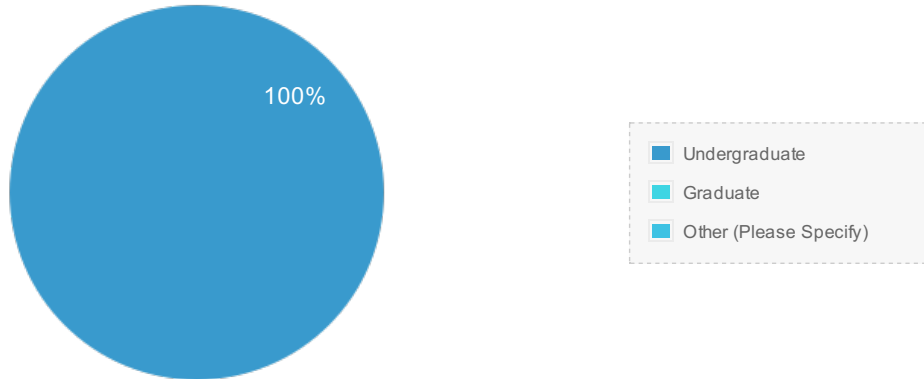

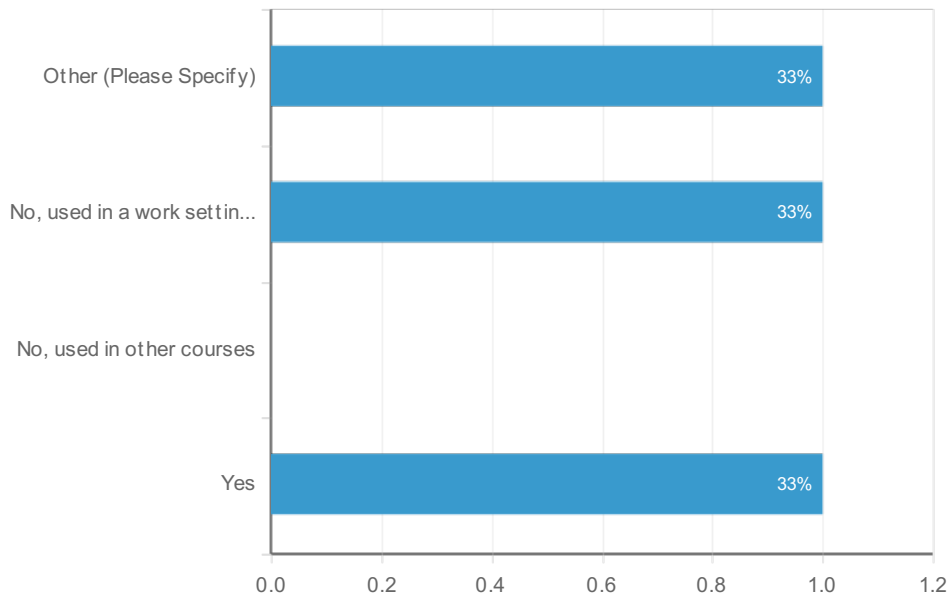

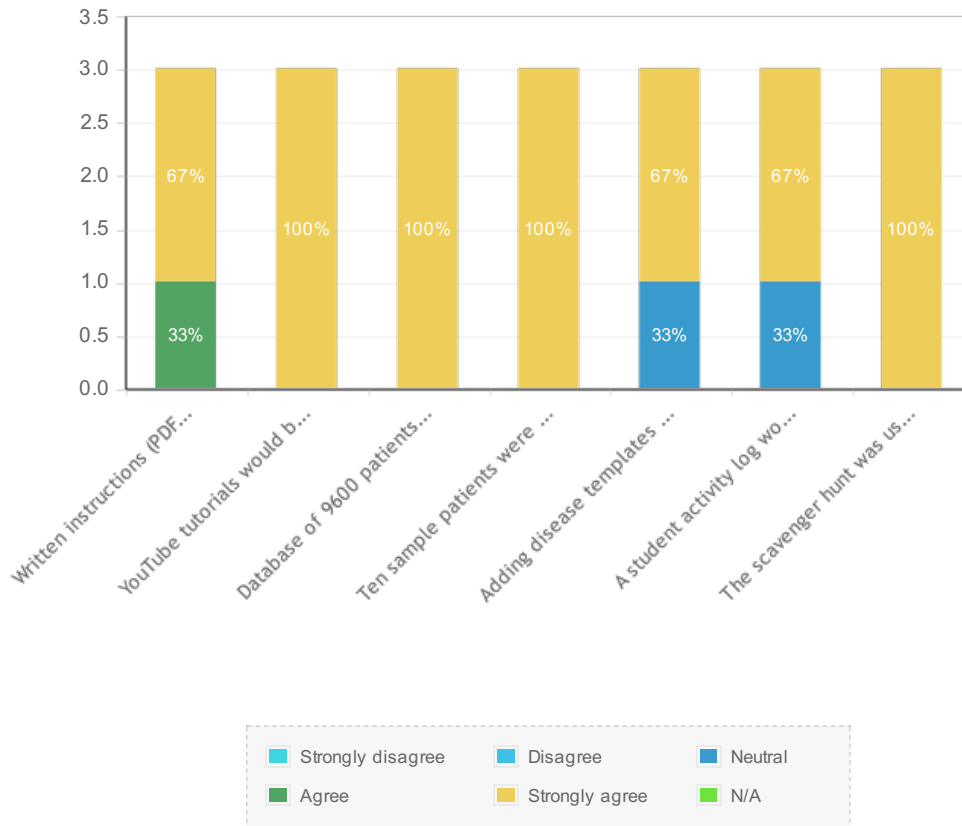

Additional Comment

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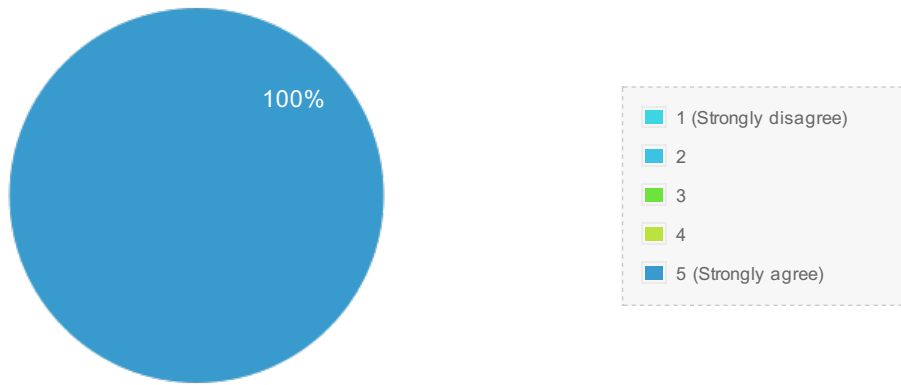

Biggest problem is that the version I was looking at had many inconsistencies and sometimes the functionality deteriorated the more I was trying to do things, e.g. setting up the user accounts--the window to do this moved down the screen with each user and ultimately disappeared. The UMD version was not working correctly as it had been a few months ago when I tried it the first time (e.g. allergies showed as none, when I knew the patient was supposed to have allergies).

2. As far as tech support, initially it would be helpful because their can be glitches that require a tweak in the code used to image instances of the master - but I don't believe it would be a frequent or time consuming level needed and using the community forum would probably be adequate to request help.
